If the patient is septic and has been diagnosed with septic shock the provider may give a colloid or crystalloid. Crystalloids versus Colloids Hypertonic crystalloids

(e.g., 7.5% saline) can be used for short-term, rapid resuscitation and intravascular volume expansion, as well as for treatment of head trauma. These solutions pull water from the interstitium down the concentration gradient into the intravascular space. They are preferred in euhydrated but hypovolemic patients. Crystalloid Fluid Therapy | Veterian Key Other crystalloid solutions are compound sodium lactate solutions (Ringer's lactate solution, Hartmann's solution) and glucose solutions (see 'Preparations containing glucose' below). Some crystalloid preparations containing additives such as potassium or glucose are used in specific circumstances, for example, in hypokalaemia and hypoglycaemia (Joint Formulary

Examples of this type of solution are physiological saline - consisting of 0.9% saline - eye drops used to freshen and clean the eyes and the 5% dextrose solution called Ringer lactate. Isotonic drinks are those that contain a concentration of salts, minerals and sugars similar to those found in the blood, with a concentration of 300 mOsm / L.
